Program Requirements

- \***Application for Admission** ([www.greenville.edu/apply](http://www.greenville.edu/apply); please apply at any time, even with all or significant amounts of KC coursework left).
- \***Completion of Kaskaskia pre-requisite coursework**, listed below, or an approved graduation plan of completion. Must have a grade of "C" or better in all transfer work.
- \***Official Transcripts.** If a student has applied to the program and has coursework from Kaskaskia, Greenville can access these records and does not need a student to request transcripts. Any coursework from somewhere besides Kaskaskia College must be requested by the student. Have them sent to ([admissions@greenville.edu](mailto:admissions@greenville.edu) or mail to Greenville University, ATTN: UTEP Admissions, 315 E. College Avenue, Greenville, IL 62246).
- \***Associates of Arts or Science from Kaskaskia College.** Please meet with an advisor, or use the catalogue, to determine Associates eligibility and to apply for KC graduation.
- \***An approved background checks.** This will be required for Kaskaskia's education classes, as well as Greenville's. You will be notified by the instructor of these courses or an admissions counselor on how to achieve this background check upon your registration.
