- \***Completion of Lewis and Clark pre-requisite coursework**, listed below, or an approved graduation plan of completion. Must have a grade of "C" or better in all transfer work.
- \***Official Transcripts.** If a student has applied to the program and has coursework from Lewis and Clark, Greenville can access these records and does not need a student to request transcripts. Any coursework from somewhere besides Lewis and Clark must be requested by the student. - \***Associates of Arts or Science from Lewis and Clark.** Please meet with an advisor, or use the catalogue, to determine Associates eligibility and to apply for L&C graduation.
- \***An approved background checks.** You will be notified by an admissions counselor on how to achieve this background check upon your registration.
